



FINELINE Applicator Tip Purchasing Guide

Simon Says Stamp carries several sizes of the [Fineline applicator tips](#).

How do you know which one you need? We have broken it down for you in a few easy steps.

Gauges:

There are three nozzle gauge sizes; 18, 20 and 24. The smaller the number the larger the size. This is the size nozzle that your fluid will need to pass through. Consider the thickness of your fluid to determine what size nozzle you will need.

18: Glues, Heavy body paints, Masking Fluid

20: Liquid Paint, Glossy Accents, glazing liquid, thin glues

24: Very fluid mixtures

Cap Sizes:

You may notice these numbers in the product description. What do they mean?

24/410

20/410

18/410

The first number is diameter of the inside measurement of the applicator cap in millimeters. The second number is the thread finish. Most craft supply bottles have the 410-thread finish. No worries there.

The easiest way to determine the size of applicator cap you need is to measure the cap of your bottle. You will need to measure outside to outside.

In this example, the cap of this glue measures 18mm. An 18/410 cap would be most appropriate
